Four Couple Longways 2nd and 4th couples improper

Music 4 x Mr. Lane's Maggot (Playford)

Figure 1

- A1: Lead up a double, cast home. Back to back left shoulder.
- A2: Lead down a double, cast home. Back to back right shoulder.
- B1: Middle four right hand star halfway, ladies drop out and men continue to turn right hand back to places. In fours left hand stars halfway, ladies now in middle places change places by right shoulder.
- B2: In fours, circle left halfway (men are now home), middle men release left hand and move along the line taking the other people in their circle with them. All two hand turn original partner once round.

Figure 2

- A1: Siding into line right shoulder, cast left into home place. Back to back left shoulder.
- A2: Siding left, cast right home. Back to back right shoulder.
- B1/2: As Fig.1

Figure 3

- A1: Arm right halfway, loop left into opposite place. Back to back left shoulder.
- A2: Arm left halfway, loop right into home place. Back to back right shoulder.
- B1/2: As Fig.1

Figure 4

- A1: "Men's" line face up, "ladies'" line face down: go forward a double & cast left into home place. Back to back left shoulder.
- A2: Men go down, ladies go up & cast right into home places. Back to back right shoulder.
- B1/2: As Fig.1

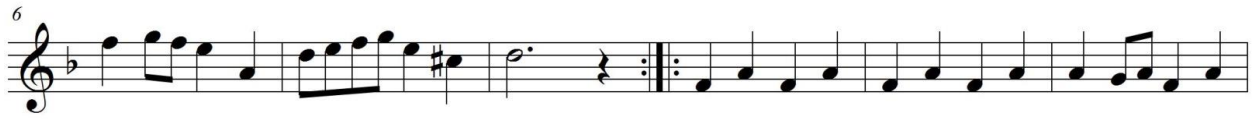

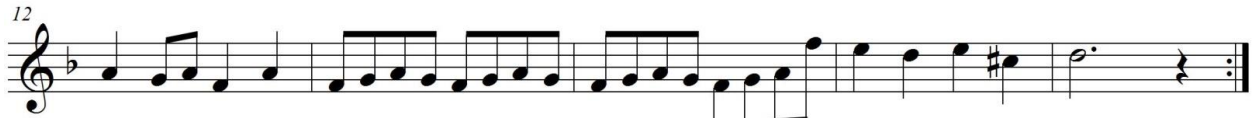
