Yarm Castle

Square set.

Music: American reels, 7 x 32 bars.

<u>Figure</u>

- A1 1-8 Head men do-si-do corner, pass right shoulder and go half way around the outside of the set to the ends of lines of four on the diagonal.
- A2 1-8 Lines forward and back, men cross to opposite lady (ladies wait for the men) and swing to reform the square.
- B1 1-8 All four ladies chain halfway, original head men only chain them back.
- B2 1-8 Promenade to the man's place, all swing.

<u>Break</u>

- A1 1-8 Ladies right hand star, men left hand star.
- A2 1-8 Allemande right partner, left to corner for grand chain the wrong way round, meet partner, box the gnat.
- B1 1-8 Grand chain (right way), swing partner.
- B2 1-8 Promenade.

Repeat once more with heads leading, then twice more with sides leading.

You can find Yarm Castle in West Street, if you look carefully. This version is slightly different to the one in "The Elmwood Collection". I think it's better!
